

**Installation Instructions**

To install “The Choir Reader” on your computer open the file “Setup” and follow the instructions on the setup wizard. The wizard will give you option of where you would like “The Choir Reader” to be installed and you will have the option of creating a desktop shortcut for easy access (recommended).

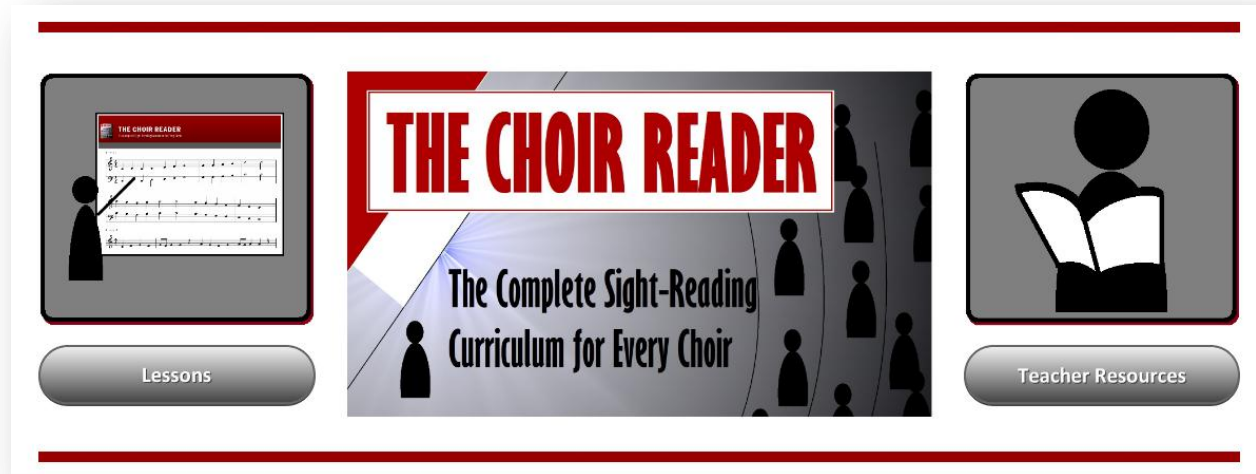
The desktop shortcut will likely have the icon of your default web browser because you will be using a web browser to access “The Choir Reader”. Any web browser should work, but because information is sometimes displayed differently in different browsers, the Chrome Browser is the one we recommend for use with “The Choir Reader”.

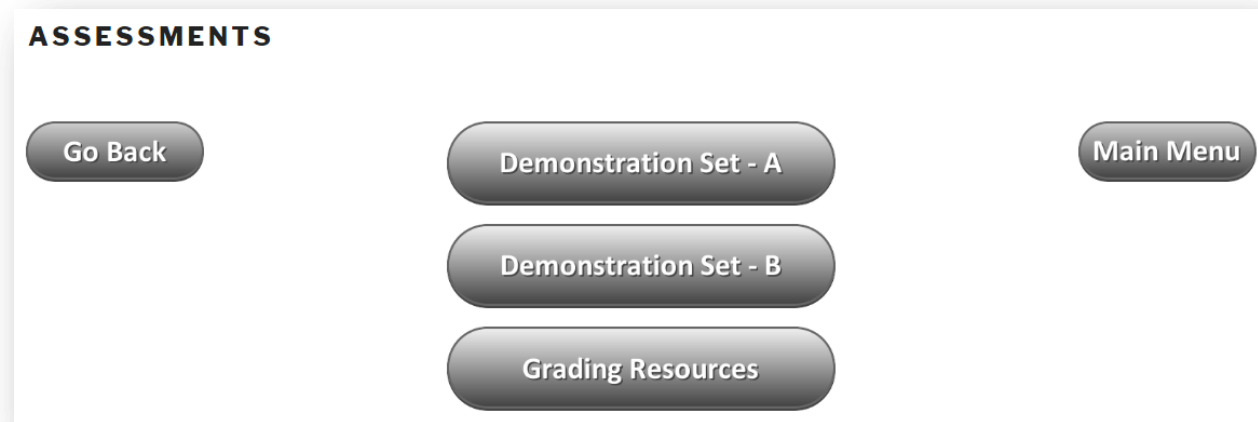
